Do not contact Minnowbrook directly for room reservations. Overnight accommodations are limited to 56 guests which includes shared rooms. Only a limited number of single rooms are available. Those staying overnight must register with the CEHD no later than Friday April 19th, and indicate individual(s) who you prefer to be paired with to share room. The CEHD must provide a final "Rooming List" to Minnowbrook by this date. CEHD Meeting Package Rate is \$144 per night, and includes; Overnight lodging, dinner day of arrival, breakfast & lunch, all breaks and evening snacks. 2019 State per diem rate for Hamilton County is \$94/night for lodging and Minnowbrook charges \$50 for meals.
